a. Architectural Review

b. Fire Mitigation - Yash

- 1. Call Jason to confirm dates
- Yash let him know about May 22, June 5 wood chipping and June 6 he will chip the wood and he is fine with the dates

2. Call South Metro to see what info would be helpful to track

- Yash called them and they didn't feel it was useful and said the best thing would be to put stickers outside their house they have a dog, cat, farm animals. They don't keep any notes to what property has what animal and their focus in a fire is the humans not animals. They didn't have advice.

3. Grant

- Celebrate fire mitigation there are 150 \$500 grants from State Farm insurance to compete for a \$500 grant. In return, as organization or individuals they give you a project. Apply for a grant and take photos that show them you did it and State Farm owns photos. This applies to Hidden Village because we can send out brochures in an email to all residents and let residents create a project and they can all apply for grant. Second way would be HOA applies for grant and find a common area to work on that we think it's a fire hazard and we apply. Third (best idea) have an early May wood chipping event and we say we do it for HOA and show them photos to

get the grant and chip on June 6. **Rion please read this and advise on your thoughts.** Did early May in the past and there was snow and ice and people weren't able to get it, so we may not get a lot. Yash said we could do it as late as May 22. Yash will apply for the money and if we get it, great! Then we will hash out the details. Yash doesn't know when they will decide, but before May he thinks.

c. Internet Access

- Kristen – Jim says we haven't heard anything new, trenching thinks it won't be until Spring until trenching. They still need the road crossing and core company permit. Originally they wanted Century link but they don't think it will reach as many people. Suzanne thinks that they didn't like the number Century Link presented. She thinks they can only work with Comcast or Century Link.

With Covid it's a moot point. Holly asked about food trucks. Suzanne said they talked about it. Most food trucks won't come out without guaranteed amount guaranteed to make.

Yash is concerned about older people in the community and they may not know what test to do. He is offering if there is a need.
