

## General Meeting Minutes 6/30/24:

-Call to order 6:42

### President updates:

- Alex staying on as treasurer, Doug staying on as member at large, open positions include President, VP, Secretary, Chairman of Architectural review, board member at large, committee positions
- Apologies for delays in rescheduling general meeting, HVPOA is in need of board members
- Fireworks reminder: keep an eye out for community safety and welfare during the holiday, fireworks are not allowed in Hidden Village, a small vegetation fire was put out by fire department in Hidden Village recently caused by birds getting into a power box
- Bear and Bobcat in community, be mindful of trash and bird feeders

### 4th of July event:

- Robyn and Brooke provided updates for 4th of July event - 3rd annual 4th of July parade, gather at arena 9:45am, quick parade route, dress up and decorate animals, Rion volunteered a trailer for a hayride
- Community decided to focus on parade for July 4th and add a potluck picnic and gymkhana as a separate event later in the summer. Will need support to help coordinate events.

### Board updates:

- Stephanie leading welcoming committee - she welcomed or is welcoming 7 new homes within the last ~year by providing welcoming packet and collecting contact information. A few homes currently listed for sale.
- Treasury update - PO Box & insurance renewed. Periodic report and registration are up to date, HVPOA in good standing with state. ~2/3rds of dues have been collected for 2024 so far plus status letter fees and donations totaling \$6,926 collected, healthy reserve fund of \$44,704.03 in bank

### Updates/questions from community:

- Concerns brought up regarding property upkeep, events, disconnected community, chipping event, dumpster day

- Core power will remove trees impacting power lines, county removing trees throughout neighborhood in easement along road, Douglas county slash is open Saturdays to drop off slash <https://www.douglas.co.us/public-works/slash-mulch-program/>. Will include this information when chipping day information is sent out
- Community feedback preferred August to hold chipping event, dumpster day feedback was mixed and is TBD
- No dumping, no trespassing, and informational signs were ordered previously and can be put up. (i.e. small amount of concrete was dumped in common area gulley on Alpine and Village)
- No architectural updates. A couple projects were started without forms and those neighbors have been contacted. Please submit architectural review forms for new projects and remind neighbors to as well.
- Hilltop widening project, no updates, pushed back potentially, website says 2025, roundabouts near current hilltop and village intersection, county will need to direct traffic through HV for a time
- Community interested in other summer event such as picnic such as expanding on potluck and gymkhana
- Prairie dogs sighted in HV, community discussed prevention methods
